To register your baptism or thanksgiving enquiry for Holy Trinity, Lickey or St Catherine's, Blackwell please come along to our relaxed monthly booking sessions at The Wheel, St Catherine's Church, B60 1BN, where you can meet Sheri our Vicar and Sandra our Parish Administrator and begin the conversation, just drop in on Saturday 4th September 4pm – 5pm, Saturday 16th October 4pm – 5pm, Saturday 6th November 10am – 11am, Saturday 4th December 4pm – 5pm.

As a general principle we encourage all those requesting baptism to be in touch with their local church, this is due to the promises that you as parents and your child's godparents will be making on behalf of your child (to bring them up within the faith community of the church), and the promises that we as a church will be making towards you as a family. However, if you consider Holy Trinity Lickey or St Catherine's Blackwell to be your family church, we can of course baptise you or your child.

Here is what we ask of you:

Firstly that the child's parents come and meet our Vicar Sheri and the team at one of our wedding and baptism drop in sessions so that we can meet each other, take details answer any questions and give you our Baptism pack. These sessions are held monthly at The Wheel, St Catherine's Church, Blackwell, B60 1BN

Secondly, as our baptisms take place during our 10am Sunday service we would expect that you come and join us as frequently as feels possible.

Thirdly, you will be invited to a baptism preparation meeting, along with other parents, at a time to suit, to talk about the promises that will be made and answer any questions that you may have.
